With reference to your application dated 17.5.2011 and subsequent inspection of the school, I am directed to convey sanction for provisional affiliation to the above said school for Senior School Certificate Examination for a period of three years w.e.f. 1.4.2012 to 31.3.2015 in the following subjects:-

(a) Languages:-

English Core, English Elective, Hindi Core, Hindi Elective,

(b) Elective Subjects:

Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, History, Political Science, Geography, Economics, Business Studies, Accountancy and Computer Science

The sanction is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions in addition to the general conditions intimated at the time of grant of provisional affiliation for secondary classes:

- 1. "The school will follow syllabi and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Senior School Certificate Examination and changes made therein from time to time."
- 2. The school will implement Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) as per the schemes of the Board upto Classes X.
- 3. As per the newly implemented CCE scheme vide Circular No. 39/20-09-2009 dated 20.09.2009, the students of class X will appear in the Summative Assessment-II (SA-II) conducted at the school level only. However, those students of class X, who opt to move out of CBSE system in Class XI to any other Board, will exercise the option to appear in the SA-II conducted at the Board level. Both the students will get the same certificate issued by the Board at the end of class X.
- 4. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State Govt./UT.
- 5. It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE schools.
- 6. The school will provide additional suitable facilities for classes XI and XII, as per requirements laid down in the rules.
- 7. It will increase the number of books in the Library and equipments in the Laboratories/Workshops with adequate games facilities etc. in consonance with the requirements of the Board for Classes XI & XII.
- 8. It will appoint only qualified staff to teach Classes XI & XII as per requirements laid down by Board.
- 9. It will provide facilities for adequate co-curricular and extra-curricular activities for the wholesome development of the students.
- 10. It will abide itself by the Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board and other rules and regulations prescribed by the Board from time to time.
